Seasons of the Fox

The red fox has the widest geographical distribution of any member of the canidae family. Many live near a fox's territory without ever realizing it. Catching even a fleeting glimpse of this discrete animal crossing a field or running along the edge of a wood is rare.

Filmed in the heart of the boreal forest on Anticosti Island in Quebec, Canada, this documentary gives an insightful look into the life of the red fox. After hundreds of hours of patient observation, the essence of this small cat-like canine has been captured. From the formation of a couple to the first steps of their kits, the camera captures touching images.

By following the daily life of a young family of foxes, the behavior patterns that have allowed this species to thrive and succeed have been documented. Parents raise their young, hunt and defend their territory. The kits learn, play and make discoveries near the den until they are finally ready to strike out on their own. The sequences of this film blend together and allow us a better understanding of this animal. Throughout the four seasons, in the midst of all the wild creatures that inhabit the boreal forest, we invite you to discover SEASONS OF THE FOX.
